High Points: Be sure to sign up at the Show office.

Age of Rider: As of January 1, 2025

Pony size: 14.2 HH & under

Novice Rider or Horse: Have not won 3 or more firsts before this show.

Stallions: Must be handled/ridden/driven by person 18yrs or older.

Large Classes: Performance classes of 15 entries or more will be split and judged separately. It may be necessary to mail ribbons.

Foals Not Weaned: May accompany their dam in the ring.

Western and English Halter classes: Horse must wear appropriate tack. Matching handler attire not required.

Youth Halter classes: "Youth" may be accompanied by an adult.

"Not So Perfect" Halter: Horse must be sound. May have scars or blemishes.

Farm Class Halter: Judged as a group. Each horse entered pays an \$8 fee. 2-3 horses from the same farm.

Rookie Rider: Rider may be accompanied by an adult. Adults must stay out of the way of the judge. Adults may hold the horse in the lineup if necessary.

Walk/Trot: You may cross enter W/T classes and canter classes.

Academy classes: Horses must be regularly used as lesson horses. Open to all breeds. Formal attire not required, however long pants, shirts with sleeves and boots are required. Judged on Equitation, without a pattern. Riders may cross enter into other performance classes.

Huntseat Pleasure: may show in a Hunt or Dressage saddle.

Western Pleasure: Snaffle bits may be used on any age horse.

Ranch Horse classes: may show in ranch type or western pleasure tack.

Border Run Classes: Horse must be enrolled in the Border Run program

Horses for Heroes class: open to Veterans, police, fireman and EMTs.

Driving: Judged using ADS rules. Minis may NOT cross enter Pony or Open Classes. Ponies may cross enter into Open classes. Any cart or carriage allowed.

\$\$ Payout Liberty: Payouts: 1st \$30, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$10
(Two minutes for music and 90 seconds to be caught)

All dogs must be kept leashed.
